SUMMARY OF WORK

TAKING INSTRUCTIONS

Meeting with you and discussing your personal circumstances and wishes, obtaining all relevant information and providing you with tailored legal advice.

PREPARING A DRAFT

Drafting the document in accordance with discussions for your consideration, taking account of further discussions and any required amendments.

SIGNING

Meeting with you to sign the final version, or providing the finalised version with signing instructions to be signed by you with your doctor.

LIAISING WITH ATTORNEYS

Corresponding with your appointed Attorneys to have registration forms signed.

REGISTRATION

Arranging registration of your Power of Attorney electronically with the Office of the Public Guardian.
